The DG & IG of Police, Gujarat has decided to set up Police-Academia Interaction Forum (PAIF) with the participation of Gujarat National Law University (GNLU), Gandhinagar; Gujarat Forensic Sciences University (GFSU), Gandhinagar and Raksha Shakti University (RSU), Ahmedabad.
