

## **ENTRANCE EXAMINATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES**

**(26 September 2021, Sunday)**

- The examination is scheduled in three shifts on **26 September 2021 (Sunday)**.
- Examination, Centre address and examination shift details have been sent to candidates through the registered email ID.
- Applicants need to arrive one and half hour prior to the commencement of examination.
- The candidates will be allowed to enter in the examination hall, after showing the print-out of the application form and print out of the email that has been sent to the applicants from the email ID: [nfsu2021@mail.digialm.com](mailto:nfsu2021@mail.digialm.com), wherein his candidature and other details are mentioned. The student should preferably carry both the print-outs for hassle free entry in the examination hall.
- The candidates need to carry personal Government identity proof (Aadhar card/PAN card/Driving Licence/Passport/Voter ID card) on the day of the entrance examination. The candidates will be permitted to enter the examination hall after verification of their identity details.
- Candidates are not permitted to carry any personal belonging inside the examination hall that include laptops, calculators, cell phones, cameras, beepers, digital diaries, bags, notebook or pieces of papers.
- The paper for the rough work will be provided at the test hall and must be returned to the invigilator after the computer based test (CBT).
- The computer based test will be conducted at respective examination centres and each student will be provided with a computer system. The detailed instructions regarding the conduct of examination will be given prior to start of examination.
- Any candidate found involved in using any type of unfair means during the examination will be expelled from the examination hall.
- All the expenses to attend entrance examination at respective centres will be borne by the candidate.
- Please ensure you have signed the print out copy of the application form and attendance sheet in the presence of invigilator.

- Also get your copy of application form signed by the invigilator and submit the same to the invigilator, failing which the candidate may be disqualified from answering the exam.
- Once the test starts, you will not be allowed to leave the test hall for any reason till the test is over and all the formalities are completed. Once you leave the test hall, you will not be allowed to re-enter and it will be assumed that you have completed computer based test (CBT)
- Candidate found violating the instruction of the test invigilator will be disqualified. The test has to be attempted in English.
- All the matters concerning to entrance examination at respective centre, the decision of Admission Committee will be the final and binding on the candidate.
- In the event of any unforeseen circumstances that may occur during the entrance examination, decisions of Admission committee shall be final and binding on the candidates.

### **Candidate Applied for Multiple Programmes**

- Candidates who have applied for more than one programme in the same group need to appear for only one programme. For example, a candidate has applied for M.Tech Cyber Security and M.Sc Digital Forensics & Information Security. As both the subjects are clubbed in one group only, therefore, he/she need to appear only in one examination. Accordingly, only one Application ID, has been shared and his/her examination score will be valid for both the programmes.
- If candidate has applied for more than one programme in different groups then he need to appear in the examination for both the programmes separately. For example, the candidate has applied for M.Tech in Cyber Security and MBA in Cyber Security. As these subjects fall in different groups, therefore there is no common entrance test and the applicant has to appear in each programme separately as per the entrance examination schedule.

## COVID-19 Guidelines

- The applicants are requested to follow COVID-19 safety protocols during the conduct of examination.
- The applicants need to wear the face mask and follow social distancing norms. Any violations of COVID-19 safety protocol will make them liable for debarment from the examination.
- Candidates must maintain social distancing starting from point of entry in the exam venue till his/her exit from the exam venue.
- Candidate must bring their own Mask, Gloves, personal hand sanitizer (50ml), transparent water Bottle, a simple pen and the examination related documents (Print out of the application form, ID Card etc.). No other items will be permitted inside exam venue.
- Candidates showing COVID-19, symptoms will not be allowed entry into the examination venue.
- Entry of Candidates will be given as per the time slot mentioned in the instructions to maintain Social Distancing at the Centre.
- Temperature of the candidates will be checked at the entry to the examination venue via a Thermo Gun. Only those candidates will be allowed inside the exam venue whose temperature is within the acceptability limits as approved by competent authorities.
- Mapping of 'Candidate Application Sequence Number and the Lab Number' will not be displayed outside the exam venue, but the same will be provided to the candidates individually at the time of entry of the candidate to the exam venue and post their application form and ID verification.
- Candidates need to follow directions given by representatives and need to stand in the circles drawn at the entry points.
- At registration desk, the candidate will be directed to sanitize his/her hands using provided sanitizer. Photograph will be captured during the registration process.
- Candidates will be under CCTV coverage throughout the exam procedure.
- Candidate is required to report at the examination venue strictly as per the time slot mentioned in the instructions.
- It is expected that candidate strictly adheres to this time slot – as entry into the test centre will be provided based upon the individual's time slot only.
- The student needs to carry self-declaration form in the format shown below and submit the same at the entry of the examination hall.
