  - Notes/Comments: 3000-4000 words
  - Book Reviews: 1500-2500 words
  - The articles should include an abstract 200-250 words along with 4-5 keywords.
3. Authorship: All contributors who have made a substantial contribution to the submission should be listed as authors/co-authors.
4. Co-authorship: Authorship: Maximum of two authors.
5. Mode of Citation: The Blue Book: A Uniform System of Citation (Nineteenth Edition).
6. Formatting- Text: Times New Roman font, 12; 1.5 line spacing.
  - Footnotes: Times New Roman font, 10; 1 line spacing.
