

Very important Instructions for candidates applied for Goa / Tripura / Goa and Tripura Campus.

1. The NFSU will conduct online entrance examination for the

 - b. The NFSU will not conduct entrance examinations for M.Sc. Cyber Security / M Sc Digital Forensics and Information Security.
 - i. Admission will be on the basis of merit list.
 - ii. The committee will publish the merit list M.Sc. Cyber Security / M Sc Digital Forensics and Information Security either on **12th Nov 2021 or 17th Nov 2021** on the admission page of the website.
 - iii. The admission committee will prepare the merit list on the basis of marks obtained in the graduation and also on the basis of category / caste certificate / PWD and CW (defence) categories campus wise, i.e., Merit list for the Goa and Tripura campus will be separate and those who applied in both the campus will be common in both the merit list.
 - c. B.Sc.-M.Sc. Forensic Science (5 years) on **15th Nov 2021, 11.00 am.**
 - d. M.Sc. Forensic Science will be conducted on **15th Nov 2021, 3.00 pm.**
 - i. The university has already sent email to each student who has paid the fees which has all the instruction related to admission.
 - ii. Candidate need to give single entrance examination if he or she has applied for same course in different campus of NFSU i.e., if students have applied for B Sc - M Sc Forensic Sciences Course for Goa and Tripura campus of NFSU then NFSU will conduct only one common examination for same course and students need to give only one common entrance examination.
 - iii. Entrance examination will be online and candidates can give an examination from home through mobile phone or laptop / desktop. It is strongly recommended to use a desktop / laptop with a good internet connection.
 - iv. Other information / instructions related to online entrance examination, you will receive in your email id 24 hours before the online examination.
 - e. It is also recommended to check the spam folder of your email in case sent email categorised as spam.
 - f. It is also strongly recommended to check the admission page very carefully for the latest update related to admission.
 - g. The NFSU is not bound to call each of the candidates individually to provide the information related to admission. NFSU will post updated information on admission page of the website (www.nfsu.ac.in) and it is the responsibility of the candidate to check the website regularly.
