- Candidates applying under the OBC-NCL (Non-Creamy Layer) category are required to produce (upload) a valid certificate on their name in English language only (issued between 01 April 2021 and 31 March 2022, based on the gross annual income for the financial year 2020-21) (as mentioned in the format available on the website [https://www.nfsu.ac.in/uploads/Updated\\_Admission\\_Guideline%20\(9\).pdf](https://www.nfsu.ac.in/uploads/Updated_Admission_Guideline%20(9).pdf))
- For Caste and Category certificates (ST/SC/OBC-NCL) and EWS that are not in the English language, the candidate is required to produce/upload a notarized copy of the English version along with the original copy of the category certificate.
- Candidates have to submit all the relevant documents on or before 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2021. Failing in submitting the documents, the candidature of the applicant shall be liable for cancellation and no further communication in this regard will be entertained.
